CARE PROVIDERS OF MINNESOTA has collaborated with Healthcare Academy to develop **a comprehensive licensed assisted living director (LALD) education program**. This program has been approved by the Minnesota Board of Executives for Long-Term Services and Supports (BELTSS) and meets the education requirements of Minnesota Rule Chapter 6400.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Program is virtual and self-paced
- 120+ hours of education
- 140 on-demand education modules
- Education modules are available 24/7
- Registrants have unlimited access to education modules for 12 months
- Registrants will receive one PDF file with Minnesota module materials and Minnesota assisted living laws and regulations
- Program is hosted on Healthcare Academy learning management platform that tracks module completion

Completion of the LALD program is just one step in earning an assisted living director professional license. LALD applicants must pass three exams - two national exams under NAB (Core & RCAL), and a Minnesota exam. Applicants also need to complete a mentorship. LALD requirements are determined by statute and rule and are administered by BELTSS which is the professional licensing board. Their website is: <https://mn.gov/boards/beltss>.

The fees for the national and state exams are not included in the LALD program fee.

MENTORSHIP

Care Providers of Minnesota has created a directory of members who are licensed assisted living directors (LALDs) or licensed health service executives (HSEs) through BELTSS and are willing to be a mentor to someone in the process of getting their LALD.
